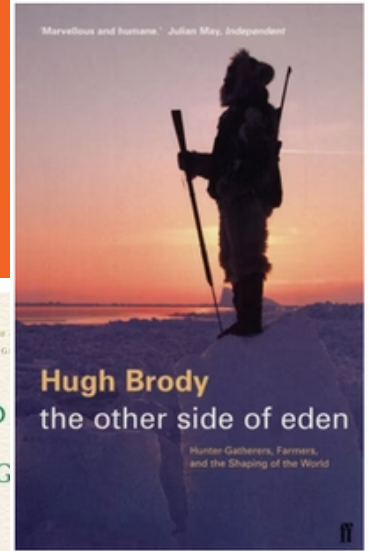
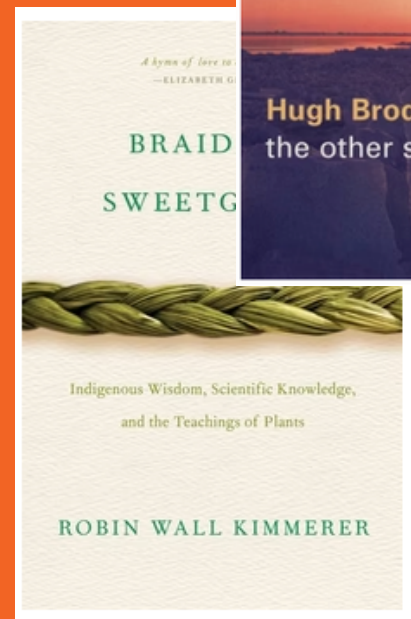

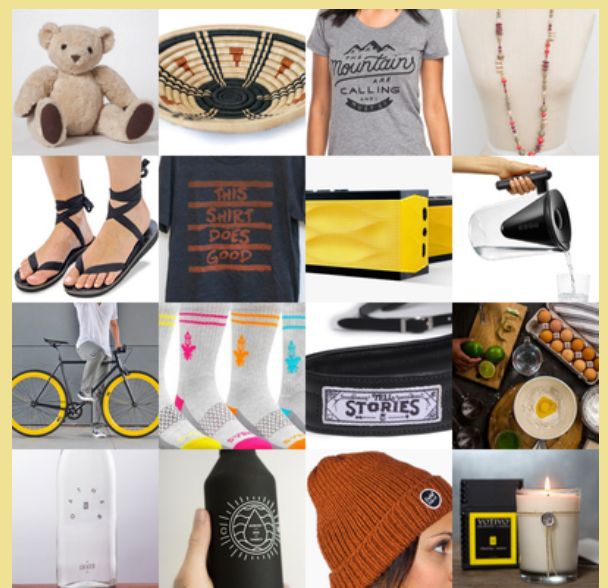

Ornaments 4 Orphans reinvests 100% of their net profit into charity partners/NGOs, artisan groups and community programs around the world, beginning in East Africa.

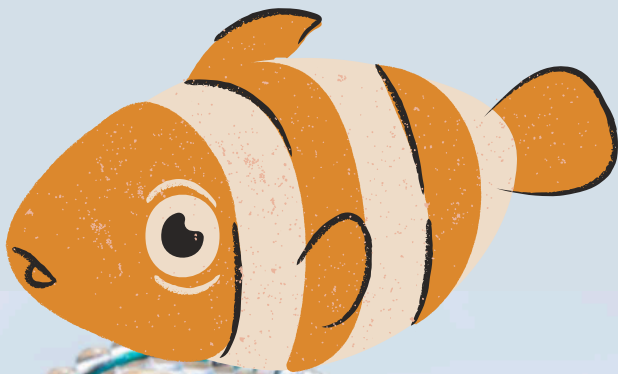
